FTC'S MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission ("FTC" or "Commission"), having filed its complaint for injunctive and other equitable relief, pursuant to Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 53(b), alleging violations of Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), hereby moves for a preliminary injunction pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(a). With its complaint, the FTC has filed a memorandum and four volumes of exhibits in support of this motion, as well as a proposed Order for Preliminary Injunction.

In addition, Plaintiff respectfully asks the Court to set dates for opposition and reply briefs.

In support of the motion, Plaintiff states:


1. The matters raised require prompt consideration by the Court.

violations of the FTC Act unless preliminary injunctive relief is granted to halt these violations and avert continued consumer injury during the pendency of this action.
