ORDER GRANTING

This matter is before the court on Defendant Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.’s Motion to Dismiss, or in the Alternative, Stay the Complaint. (Dkt. 9.) As of September 26, 2018, the matter was fully briefed, and on September 28, 2018, Plaintiff Mazuma Capital Corporation filed a Request to Submit for Decision pursuant to Civil Rule 7-3 of the United States District Court for the District of Utah Rules of Practice.

Having reviewed the written submissions of the parties, including law and facts set forth therein, the court hereby grants Defendant’s “alternative motion” to stay the complaint.

Accordingly, the court will take no further action in this case until the parallel action, currently pending in the Western District of New York, has been resolved. *See Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc. v. Mazuma Capital Corp.*, Case No. 6:18-cv-6416-CJS (W.D.N.Y.)
