-FORUM SELECTION - Motion is DENIED.

Fourm selection clauses will not be enforced if they are unreasonable. CQL ORIGINAL PRODUCTS v. NATIONAL HOCKEY LEAGUE PLAYERS ASSOCIATION (1995) 39 Cal.App. 4th 1347, 1354.

A clause will be found to be unreasonable if there is lack of adequate notice that a party is agreeing to a particular jurisdiction. HUNT v. SUPERIOR COURT (2000) 81 Cal.App.4th 901, 908. There is no notice as to the venue.

The Court need not address the issue of unconscionability. There is no proof that the bargaining was

Forum non-conveniens is an equitable doctrine wherein it is determined - by the court's equitable power that the action may be more appropriate somewhere else. STANGVIK v. SHILEY (1991) 54 Cal.3d 744. The inquiry is not whether some other state or country provides a better forum but whether California is a "seriously" inconvenient forum. FORD MOTOR COMPANY v. INSURANCE COMPANY OF NORTH AMERICA (1995) 35 Cal.App.4th 604. It is defendant's burden to show inconvenient forum. Defendant has not provided any evidence to support this argument. Without any evidence, defendant fails to meet its burden.
