Dear Mr. Hawkins:

This law firm represents Jason Good and Good, Inc. The purpose of this letter is to make final demand that you return the \$25,000 that Mr. Good wired to you on or about August 18, 2012, for what turned out to be a nonexistent loan.

When Mr. Good was brought to you by Paul Jacobellis, it was Mr. Good's understanding that you and your company were going to provide him with financing. Pursuant to your August 1, 2012, proposal, Mr. Good wired to you \$25,000 as an underwriting deposit. Subsequently, it became clear that you were not in fact going to provide financing, that no underwriting was being done, and that you had no intention of returning the money paid by Mr. Good.

In retrospect, it appears that your proposal and conduct merely represented a scheme to defraud Mr. Good out of \$25,000. You have had his money for three months, without providing financing to Mr. Good.

This conduct appears to be actionable under Washington's Consumer Protection Act. Unless Mr. Good is made whole, we have been instructed to bring a lawsuit against you and Integrity in the State of Washington. In that lawsuit, we will seek the \$25,000 advanced by Mr. Good, exemplary damages of \$25,000 under the Consumer Protection Act, and an award of reasonable attorney fees under that same Act. Should we be forced to proceed with litigation, your exposure will far exceed the \$25,000 Mr. Good advanced to you.

Please forward the sum of \$25,000 to this office, made payable to Jason Good and/or Good, Inc., by the close of business on November 26, 2012. Should the funds be received by that date, we will consider this matter concluded in its entirety. Should we not have the \$25,000 in hand by that date, however, we will have no choice but to proceed with a lawsuit against you and Integrity in the Superior Court of Washington. We urge your immediate attention to this matter.
