1) I am sending an original signature of my Pro Se Scheduling Notification to both the Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit Clerk at Foley Square and one to the Appeal's Clerk at the District Court in Central Islip.(My reason is that I am uncertain who the notification should be sent to.)

2) I am not clear what is meant by District Agency Number. I am therefore relying on 11cv753(ADS) and 02-767(ADS).

3) I am using a filing date of 09-08-2011. My computation was based on the following dates: I received the Court of Appeals information including the "Pro Se Scheduling Notification" on June 9, 2011. If any of the above is not correct then please contact me at the address that I have provided in my "Pro Se Scheduling Notification"

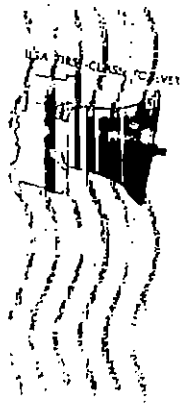

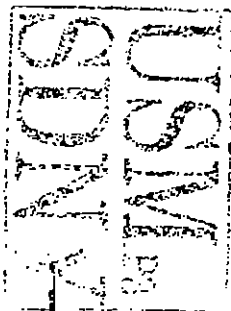

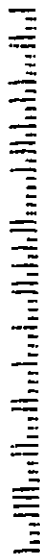
