The government respectfully submits this letter to request that the sentencing for the defendant Barry Drayer, currently scheduled for December 15, 2006, be adjourned for a period of two weeks. In consultation this morning with our Office's Victim Witness Coordinator, I was made aware that notifications to the victims in this matter were not updated to reflect the new sentencing date. Accordingly, the victims have not be notified of the sentencing date on December 15, 2006. Because of the high number of victims, and the fact that many of the victims are located in states across the country, the Government respectfully requests that the sentencing in the above-referenced case be adjourned for two weeks so that notification of the sentencing can be made to victims to provide them with an opportunity to appear at the sentencing if they so wish.
